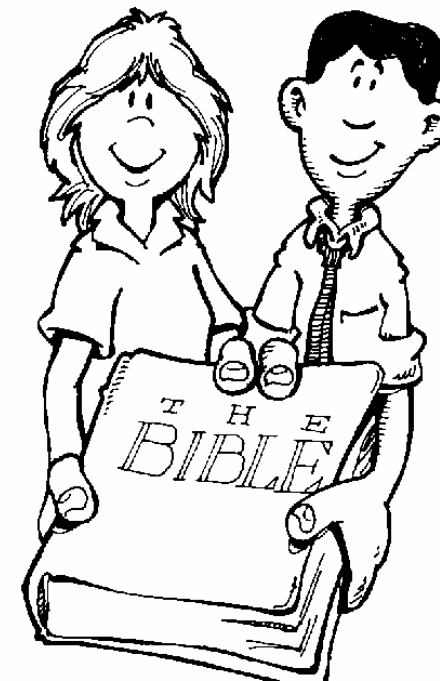

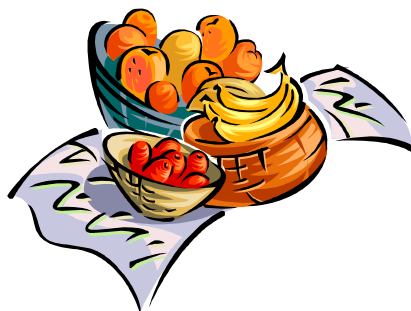
WELCOME
